C. OUTLINE OF MAJOR CONTENT AREAS

1. Student will become proficient with digital non-linear editing workflow and the basic technical aspects of Final Cut Pro, which will assist in preparation for those interested and serious about pursuing Level 1 FCP Apple Pro Certification
2. Student will consider, exercise and present connections between editing theory, aesthetics and post-production techniques
3. Student will learn editing terminology and apply it in practice through writing, presentation, tutorials and hands-on editing projects

1. Student will utilize and focus on the post-production phase of filmmaking
2. Student will demonstrate knowledge of film history, film theory, production and post-production aesthetics
3. Student will demonstrate knowledge of basic filmmaking practices and techniques.
