PNSG 1100: Foundations of Nursing Practice II

This course builds on the PNSG 1000 Foundations of Nursing Practice I course and introduces second semester practical nursing students to basic nursing concepts and skills. Concepts will include: the nursing process, medical and surgical asepsis, documentation, fluid and electrolyte balance, death and dying, ostomies, gastric suctioning, tracheostomy care, and diagnostic tests. Procedures are demonstrated and practiced in the laboratory setting. This course will help prepare nursing students for the clinical courses in the DCTC Practical Nursing Program and for nursing practice.

Prerequisites: PNSG1000, HEAL 1750, HEAL1150, HEAL1101, & PSYC 1350. Students must take this course prior to or concurrent with PNSG1400
