A continuation of MUS 107, this course focuses on four-voice writing in Baroque chorale style. Diatonic harmony, non-harmonic tones, principles of harmonic progression, modulation to closely related keys, secondary dominant/diminished chords, harmonic implications of the melodic minor scale, motivic development, and level-appropriate ear training/sight signing/keyboard exercises. Includes an introduction to jazz chord symbol nomenclature through ninth chords.
